

















#### SCHOOL OF DIVINE PRIORITIES (SODIP)

ny life that is not spent on the divine priorities is a wasted life. The greatest goal of life is to discover and pursue God's priorities – to accurately discern and then seek to fulfill the divine expectations on your life. To miss this is to miss everything – far better not to have been born than to live life and at the end discover that you wrote off point and missed the mark.

True greatness is found in those who live for divine agenda. It was said of David that he "served God's will and purpose and counsel in his own generation" (Acts 13:36 Amplified). He lived life on target; no wonder he was called the man after God's heart. It seems that in every generation the chief longing of God's heart is for people who understand His purpose – His

priorities – and then live to execute it to the uttermost. Only a life spent on the divine priorities can say with Paul at the end, "I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time has come for my departure. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness..." 2Tim.4:6-8 NIV.



Most people, however, are not focused on the divine priorities. They are engrossed in the affairs of this life: consumed by the noise of earth, they miss the music of heaven; obsessed by time, they lose out on eternity. They are more interested in finding solutions to temporal life problems than discovering and fulfilling God's heart for their generation. They focus on survival rather than on a life of impact and eternal significance. What they fail to realize is that God has designed that everything else will be guaranteed to the person who will seek *first* the divine priorities.

The Divine Priorities Training Program (School of Divine Priorities) has been carefully designed to equip you with the life and focus needed to live life on target. Every component of SODiP has something specific to contribute to making you the person you ought to be so you can accomplish the divine mandate on your life. It focuses on life training rather than mere knowledge; it is inflammatory in nature, seeking to ignite your heart, not just to inflate your head. It will both inform and inflame: you will gain understanding — with a burning heart! Thus equipped with a Christ-like life and holy fire, you will be ready for your journey into the purposes of God.

## **OBJECTIVE**

Christ-like leaders who know their God, are possessed by the Spirit and are driven by a deep understanding of divine priorities to harvest the nations and reproduce their kind on the earth.

### TRAINING FORMAT

The School of Divine Priorities is composed of six sessions, spread over a period of two years. Participants are required to attend three sessions each year; each session lasts a week and includes lectures and other activities. The School of Divine Priorities employs highly catalytic training methods to communicate the material, in the power of the Holy Spirit. This multiplies the impact of the training. Use of media, lectures, practical exposures and participant projects etc ensure that your experience of SODiP will not be purely theoretical.

At the end of the sixth and final session of SODIP, a commissioning service is held for participants who have completed the course requirements.

# ADMISSIONS, FEES, ACCOMMODATION AND SUNDRY MATTERS

SODiP is open to all but priority will given to full-time ministers and marketplace leaders who desire to use their varied platforms to advance the kingdom of God. Couples can be admitted to SODiP.

No tuition or registration fees are charged for The School of Divine Priorities. Feeding and accommodation (at the training venue or in homes) will be made available as the Lord provides. Participants who desire hotel accommodation will be allowed to make such arrangements provided they will be able to honor the rigorous schedule of the program. Participants (and their recommending agencies or churches) are encouraged to give what they can to help cover the cost of the training for themselves and others. Participants will be expected to purchase training manuals, or other books/materials that may be recommended.
